WHEREAS, these good citizens comprise a cross section of vocations, including students of higher learning, doctors, attorneys, executives, skilled and unskilled laborers, and the retired--our senior citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the mobile home industry is clearly an important economic segment of our life in Minnesota,



"MOBILE HOME WEEK"


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to mark it well.
