




Dear Mr. Donovan:

ORDINANCE NO. 61-10

CHAPTER 99

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE DATES FOR  
THE REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL of the Village of New Hope Ordains:

1. The date of the regular village election now held on the first Monday in December each year is hereby changed; and the regular village election shall hereafter be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November each year.
