of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Highways for the period commencing July 10, 1961, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said EMERY COX, JR. at the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9,000) Dollars per year, to be paid from the appropriation made for the Department of Highways.
