A PROCLAMATION FOR "COCKER STATE CAT WEEK"

WHEREAS, the Cocker State Cat Club, Inc., a subsidiary organization of the American Cat Fanciers Association, will sponsor "The Seventh Annual Royal Merit Quadruple Championship Cat Show" on September 23 and 24, 1961, and

WHEREAS, this year a new classification has been added to the championship classes for the benefit of the Boy Scouts of America for those who desire to enter household pets for the purpose of earning Boy Merit Badges, and

WHEREAS, young people gain a great deal of self-reliance and responsibility in the care and training of family pets,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby declare the week of September 17 through September 24, 1961 as
