ORDINANCE NO. 271

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITE OF THE CITY OF MARCHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNFLATTED LAND NOT EXCHIDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Gouncil of the City of Mershall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, fitte of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

That part of the Couthwest quarter (SW\f) of the Northwest quarter (NW\f) of Section Mine (9), in Township One Mundred Eleven (111) north, of Mango Forty-one (11) west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at the NW corner of the SW\f of the NW\f of said Section 9.
