




ORDINANCE NO. 271

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

That part of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine (9), in Township One Hundred Eleven (111) north, of Range Forty-one (41) west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at the NW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 9, Township 111 north, Range 41 west; thence S 80 degrees 30 minutes E along the north line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, a distance of 658 feet; thence S 9 degrees 03 minutes W a distance of 204 feet; thence N 80 degrees 30 minutes W a distance of 66 feet; thence S 9 degrees 03 minutes W a distance of 120 feet; thence N 80 degrees 30 minutes W a distance of 592 feet to the west line of said Section 9; thence N 9 degrees 03 minutes W along the west line of said Section 9 a distance of 324 feet to the place of beginning, subject to existing public easements.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 4.71 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.

PETITION

TO THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL LYING AND BEING
IN THE COUNTY OF LYON AND STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Your petitioners Niels L. Nielsen and Lucille Nielsen, husband and wife,
respectfully represent and state that they are the owners in fee simple of the lands
and premises lying and being in the County of Lyon and State of Minnesota, described
as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of
Section Nine (9), in Township One Hundred Eleven (111) north, of Range
Forty-one (41) west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows:
Beginning at the NW corner of the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 9, Town-
ship 111 north, Range 41 west; thence S 80 degrees 30 minutes E along the
north line of said $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$, a distance of 658 feet; thence S 9 degrees
03 minutes W a distance of 204 feet; thence N 80 degrees 30 minutes W a
distance of 66 feet; thence S 9 degrees 03 minutes W a distance of 120
feet; thence N 80 degrees 30 minutes W a distance of 592 feet to the west
line of said Section 9; thence N 9 degrees 03 minutes W along the west
line of said Section 9 a distance of 324 feet to the place of beginning,
subject to existing public easements.

That your petitioners have caused said premises to be surveyed and platted
into Blocks, Lots, Streets, Parks and Walks as more fully appears by and in the
plat thereof, a true and correct copy of which is hereto annexed and submitted herewith.

That said premises abutt upon the incorporated City of Marshall, Minnesota,
an incorporated City within the County of Lyon and State of Minnesota, having a
population of less than 10,000 inhabitants.

That your petitioners desire to have said premises annexed to the City of
Marshall, Minnesota, as an addition thereto to be known and named "Nielsen's
Second Addition".

WHEREFORE, Your petitioners pray that the honorable council make, enter and
adopt an ordinance declaring "Nielsen's Second Addition" as an addition to such City
and annexing said lands and premises to said City as provided by Section 414.03,
Minnesota Statutes Annotated.
