A PROCLAMATION FOR "HYDRONICS WEEK"

WHEREAS, the heating industries have made invaluable contributions to better and more comfortable living for all of our citizens, and

WHEREAS, the new advances in convenience and cleanliness of today's efficient heating systems are due to the research programs carried on by our heating and cooling industries, and

WHEREAS, it is good to set aside a time to encourage our citizens to inform themselves of the technological and practical developments in the field of home and industrial heating and to recognize the comforts they provide,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare the week of September 17 through September 23, 1961, as

"HYDRONICS WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to better acquaint themselves with the progress being made in convenience, economy, cleanliness and efficiency of the modern heating system.
