A PROCLAMATION FOR "SERBIAN DAY"

WHEREAS, Minnesota has formed a strong and vigorous society through the assimilation of diverse cultures and national origins, and

WHEREAS, our heritage and background are an integral part of contemporary customs and interests, and

WHEREAS, our people of Serbian origin have contributed generously to our now flourishing timber and logging industry and to the iron ore industry from which we have all richly benefitted in the past,

I, WINSTON E. ELMER, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare July 15 and 16, 1961, as

"SERBIAN DAY"

in Minnesota and urge that our residents recognize and pay tribute to the outstanding contribution made to our society by our fellow citizens of Serbian heritage.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this *seventeenth* day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred sixty-one and of the State, the one hundred fourth.
