A PROCLAMATION FOR "LAMBTIME, U.S.A."

WHEREAS, the sheep industry of America is one of the country's oldest and most respected agricultural enterprises, and

WHEREAS, the producer of lamb is a worthy citizen and has taken upon himself the commendable task of promoting his own products through a self-help program of promotion and advertising, and

WHEREAS, the products of sheep add much to the welfare and economy of this area and the nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare the month of September, 1961,
as

"LAMBTIME, U.S.A."

In Minnesota and urge all citizens to observe this event by becoming aware of the number and nature of products derived from the production of sheep, and use them to the fullest.
