Ordinance No. 179

**AN ORDINANCE CHANGING
DATE OF REGULAR VIL-
LAGE ELECTION
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF HERON
LAKE, MINNESOTA, DO
ORDAIN:**

Section 1

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Statutes authorize the council to designate the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as the regular village election date,

AND WHEREAS the council believes that this change in election date should be made in this village,

BE IT ORDAINED That commencing with the 1961 regular village election the regular village election of Heron Lake, Minnesota shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
