A PROCLAMATION FOR "NEWSPAPERBOY DAY"

- WHEREAS, each day approximately 700,000 young boys sell, distribute and collect for 43,000,000 newspapers; and
- WHEREAS, the training these boys receive in financial responsibility and the faithful performance of duty is of great value to their future success as a useful citizen of our nation; and
- WHEREAS, it is well that we set aside a day each year to recognize and pay tribute to their work which is so often overlooked in the hurried pace of today's living,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 21, 1961 as

"NEWSPAPER BOY DAY"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to remind themselves of the contribution made by our newspaperboys to our daily convenience and benefit.
