ORDINANCE 0144

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TO THE VILLAGE OF AITHIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH I HEREOF.

The village council of the village of Aithin ordains as follows:

I.

The land herein described abuts upon the limits of Aithin and is not now located in any municipality:

"Pettor's First Addition to Aithin Township", according to the filed and recorded plat thereof; and all of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (1/4 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4) lying South and East of the plat of "Pettor's First Addition to Aithin Township", in Section Twenty-six (26), Township Forty-seven (47), Range Twenty-seven (27), Aithin County, Minnesota.

II.

A part of said land is platted as "Pettor's Addition to Aithin Township". A part is unplatted, and the whole consists of approximately 11.4 acres.

III.

All of the owners of the premises described in Paragraph I of this ordinance have duly petitioned the village of Aithin to include said premises within the village.

IV.

The Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the village of Aithin and the territory affected as described in Paragraph I hereof that said premises be annexed to the village of Aithin.

V.

The premises described in Paragraph I hereof are hereby declared annexed to and a part of the village of Aithin.
