A PROCLAMATION FOR "NATIONAL FOREST PRODUCTS WEEK"

WHEREAS, the forests of Minnesota are one of the great natural resources from which we have gained much of our strength and prosperity, and

WHEREAS, the proper management and utilization of those forests provides employment for many people and assures our needs for pulp, paper, building materials and a myriad of useful products derived from wood, and

WHEREAS, the efforts of those engaged in the forests, the mills, the lumber yards and all related activities contribute substantially to the support of our economy and to the health and well being of all of our people, and

WHEREAS, the forest lands also provide public recreation, wild life habitat and watershed protection, and

WHEREAS, by calling attention to those vital values we stimulate the consideration of ways to encourage further development in the common interests;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elymer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 15 - 21, 1961, as

"NATIONAL FOREST PRODUCTS WEEK"

In Minnesota and urge all citizens to cooperate in a similar observance throughout the United States by recognizing and becoming better informed as to the contributions made by the forest products industries to our way of life.
