

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I,  
Lyndon A. Smith, Attorney General of the State of Minne-  
sota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute,  
and particularly by an Act of the Legislature entitled  
"An Act relating to the duties and powers of the Attorney  
General and his assistants," approved April 17, 1905, as  
amended, do hereby constitute and appoint Henry C. Flannery  
of Minneapolis, Minnesota, to be an Assistant Attorney  
General of the State of Minnesota for the period commencing  
February 1, 1916, and ending the first Monday in January,  
1917, and until his successor is appointed and qualified,  
unless sooner revoked.
