A PROCLAMATION FOR "PATRIOTIC EDUCATION WEEK"

WHEREAS, the study of American History is a required subject for all Minnesota high school students and such a study of history should be more than a required school subject because of the principles laid down by our forefathers for the development of our future, and

WHEREAS, Americans need to be reawakened to their great past, to the sacrifices, hard work and diligent efforts that have gone into the creation of American democracy, and

WHEREAS, The Minnesota Society, Children of the American Revolution, is working toward the accomplishment of these goals through a special patriotic education committee,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer E. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare the week of October 12-19, 1961 as PATRIOTIC EDUCATION WEEK in Minnesota and do hereby urge that both adults and children in Minnesota devote themselves to refreshing their memory and rededication of their lives to the principles of American Liberty.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one and of the State, the one hundred fourth.
