- WHEREAS, self help, initiative and imagination have combined to build the Minnesota turkey industry to the height it now enjoys,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 16 to October 23 as


"NATIONAL TURKEY WEEK IN MINNESOTA"
