A PROCLAMATION FOR "HUNGARIAN FREEDOM FIGHTERS DAY"

WHEREAS, October 23, 1951, marks the fifth anniversary of the day when the Hungarian people added to their history of courage and love of liberty by revolting against Soviet oppression and Communist dictatorship, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that we memorialize the great sacrifices and bravery demonstrated by the people of Poland to free themselves from tyranny,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 23, 1961, as

"HUNGARIAN FREEDOM FIGHTERS DAY"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to mark this occasion by paying tribute to freedom fighters throughout the world, especially remembering the historic revolution of the people of Poland.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one, and of the State the one hundred fourth.
