A PROCLAMATION FOR "PAUL BERTHELMAN DAY IN MINNESOTA"

- WHEREAS, the story of Paul Bertelman stands as a symbol of the Scandinavian heritage which has played such a great part in the development of the American character, and
- WHEREAS, the life of Paul Bertelman typifies a restlessness and a breadth of vision that has become identified with the American spirit, and
- WHEREAS, our freedoms are competing with slavery which is unparalleled in ruthlessness and tyrannical in cruel cynicism, and
- WHEREAS, freedom will win the contest by application of the qualities of resourcefulness, independence of spirit, vigor of intellect and strength of body typified by Paul Bertelman and the Scandinavian heritage,

Now, BEING, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate October 9, 1961 as

"PAUL BERTHELMAN DAY IN MINNESOTA"

and further urge observance of every succeeding October 9 to the memory of this great man, urging our people to pay tribute to his while working to increase the attitude of creative restlessness in our people—an attitude which is vital to our nation if we are to continue our role as the leader of the Free World.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this ninth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty one, and of the state the one hundred fourth.
