AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CHITE BEAR LAILE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota by the sole owner or all of the owners in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of White Bear Loke, Minnesota:

All that part of Lot II, Block 4, Rearrangement of White Bear Park lying westerly of the westerly line of right-of-way of Trunk Highway No. 61 (as described in 1068 of Nortgages P.580) and lying easterly of the easterly right-of-way line of former Trunk Highway No. 61, except all that part of the south 176.81 feat thereof lying west of a line running parallel to and distant 735 feet west of the east line of said Lot II, according to the plot thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County and State

ORDINANCE No. 1117

AN ORDINANCE Annexing to fine City, of Rochester, Minnesota, Lot Five (5). Allendale—a Sub-Division of the Southwest quarter of Section 22. Township 107 North, Range 14. West, Oimsted. County, Minnesota.

The Common Council of the City of Rochester do ordain:
Secticon I. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City. of Rochester, signed by all the owners of all the land described therein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land to the City of Rochester. The land described in said petition for annexation is located in Oimsted County. Minnesota, and is described as follows:

Lot Five (5), Allendale — a Sub-Division of the Southwest quarter of, secticon 22. Township 107. North, Range 14 West.

Secticon 2. The Common Council of, the City of Rochester does hereby determine that the lands described in Section 1 abut upon the present territorial ilmits of the City of Rochester, are so conditioned as to be properly subjected to Municipal Government, and, the annexation of said lands will be in the best interests of the City of Rochester and of the lands affected.
