WHEREAS, this Society has grown in membership until it now claims over 7,000 individual members affiliated with 76 area chapters located in every state of the union, and

WHEREAS, the objectives of the Society include research and development of safety data, establishment of safety codes in government and industry, the development of college courses in industrial safety, and the establishment of courses, institutes and training sessions to inform our citizens of good safety habits in all occupations, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of November 6-12, 1961 as
