

ORDINANCE NO. 334

AN ORDINANCE EXPLAINING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON  
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington do ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number, of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

All that part of Government Lot 1 in Section 27, Township 102 North, Range 10 West, in the County of Nobles and State of Minnesota, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 1, thence running South on the West Line of said Lot 1, a distance of 1624.50 feet to the point of beginning; thence South 60 degrees 00 minutes East for a distance of 115 feet, more or less, to the meander line of the shore of West Okabena Lake; running thence Southwesterly along the meander line of said lake to the West Line of said Lot 1; thence running North on the West Line of said Lot 1, a distance of 209 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described, is three tenths (.3) acres.

Section 3. A hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after publication of the notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein above upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Corporation, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
