

MORRISON COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

WE THE UNDERSIGNED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE TERRITORY
HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, HEREBY PETITION YOUR HONORABLE BOARD TO CALL
AN ELECTION OF THE VOTERS RESIDING WITHIN THE TERRITORY HEREINAFTER
DESCRIBED FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE DETERMINATION OF THE INCORPORATION
OF THE VILLAGE OF LASTRUP, LOCATED IN SAID MORRISON COUNTY. THE
DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND AND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TERRITORY TO BE
EMBRACED WITHIN SAID PROPOSED VILLAGE ARE AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

NUMBER, ^{OF} ACTUAL RESIDENTS THEREON IS 220, AND THAT THE NAME OF THE
SAID PROPOSED VILLAGE IS LASTRUP.

YOUR PETITIONERS FURTHER SHOW AND STATE THAT BETWEEN THE
14TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1916 AND THE 25TH DAY OF JANUARY 1916,
THEY CAUSED A CENSUS TO BE TAKEN OF THE RESIDENT POPULATION RESIDING ON
THE TERRITORY TO BE EMBRACED IN SAID PROPOSED VILLAGE, AS HEREIN-
BEFORE DESCRIBED, AND THAT SAID CENSUS SHOWED SAID RESIDENT
POPULATION TO BE 220, AS WILL BE MORE FULLY SHOWN BY EXHIBIT "A"
HERETO ATTACHED AND MADE A PART THEREOF.
