A PROGLAMATION FOR CIVIL SERVICE WEEK

IMEREAS, Federal employees have set high standards of integrity and performance in the service of their nation, and

WHEREAS, these high standards are made possible by a Civil Service system based solely on morit, and

WHEREAS, each year on the anniversary of the passage of the Civil Service Act of 1883, the American Federation of Government Employees sponsors special programs and activities to acquaint the public with the history and principles of the morat system,

NOW, THERMFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 14 through 20 as

"CEVIL SERVICE WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to join in the observance of the seventy-minth anniversary of the signing of the Civil Service Act.
