A PROCLAMATION FOR "YOUTH TEMPERENCE EDUCATION WEEK"

WHEREAS, the future of Minnesota and the Nation depends on respect for the moral law, based on regard for temperence and development of character, and

WHEREAS, the challenge of today serves as a great test for these qualities which undergird our society, and

WHEREAS, a mobilization is needed to marshal all civic, educational, religious, and social agencies in the drive to protect American youth by instilling awareness of the need for temperence, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that a period of time be set aside to call attention to this endeavor,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 8 through the 15, as

"YOUTH TEMPERENCE EDUCATION WEEK"

and urge that citizens in churches, schools, organizations and as individuals observe the need for youth temperence education during this time.
