- WHEREAS, this year, 1962, will commemorate the 41st Anniversary of the Minnesota School Safety Patrol,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 17 through February 24 as


"SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL WEEK"
