ORDINANCE NO. 2/4

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CHANHASSEN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of tho Village of Chanhassen, Minnesota, by the sole owners of the following described real estate, to have such land annexed and included within the Village of Chanhassen, Minnesota:

The West 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4; the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 and Government Lot 4, all in Section 11, Township 116, Range 23.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced in the foregoing description and bounded as described is 155 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Chanhassen, Minnesota and of the territory affected, and that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subject to Village governmont.

Section L. Therefore, the Village of Chanhassen, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same hereby is annexed to and included in the Village of Chanhassen, Minnesota as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be enforced from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication;
