- WHEREAS, the electronics industry of Minnesota has marked a decade of growth and expansion with increasing job opportunities for our citizens and renewed recognition for the technological excellence of our Minnesota firms, and
- during 1962 the electronics industry of Minnesota WHEREAS, will experience continued growth, with the outlook that more than 1,500 new jobs will be added to the already impressive total of the 42,000 that now exist in this field, and
- WHEREAS, Minnesota is gaining attention, through the achievements of its electronics industry, as an ideal State in which to attract more investment, from the stand-point of its top qualified labor force--people who possess the intellectual and physical character-istics to do a really first-rate job for their industry and the Nation it serves, and
