CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION OF OPTIONAL PLAN "A"

TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY OF SIBLEY:

I, Veldon G. Thiem, duly elected and acting clerk of the Village of Gibbon, Sibley County, do hereby certify that at the regular election held in the Village on December 5th, 1961, the following question was submitted to the voters of the village:

"Shall Optional Plan A, modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village?"

I further certify that the affirmative votes cast on the foregoing proposition were -94- and the negative votes were -83- and the question of adoption of Optional Plan A received an affirmative majority of the votes cast on the question.
