

ORDINANCE NO. 1639

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
CITY OF ALBERT LEA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND

Introduced by Councilman Ronald Blakeslee

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Albert Lea, Minnesota signed by all of the owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Albert Lea, Minnesota:

Lots 24 through 30 inclusive and the east 155 feet of lot 31 -
Jobs Building Sub. - a part of the N. E. quarter; Sec. 21, T. 102 N.
R. 21 West; County of Freeborn; State of Minnesota

The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 7.20 acres.

THE CITY OF ALBERT LEA DOES OATH:

Sec. 1. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Albert Lea and to the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Sec. 2. That the property heretofore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Albert Lea as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Sec. 3. That the property annexed by this ordinance is hereby zoned as M-2, Heavy Industrial District.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copies thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State and from and after its passage and publication.
