

ORDINANCE FOR THE ANNEXATION OF LAND  
PURSUANT TO LAW 1929, CHAPTER 686,  
SECTION 3, AS AMENDED BY LAW 1931,  
CHAPTER 449, SECTION 3.

Ordinance No. 10

WHEREAS a Petition signed by a majority in number of the citizens  
of the hereinbefore described territory has been filed with the governing  
body of the Village of Sunfish Lake, Minnesota, setting the annexation of  
the following described territory to the Village of Sunfish Lake, to-wit:

True part of the Southeast Quarter (sqd) of  
Section 32, Township 28 North, Range 22 West,  
of the Fourth Principal Meridian, lying east  
of the west line of Robert Street (State Trunk  
Highway No. 3, formerly known as State Trunk  
Highway No. 210) and lying south of Salton  
Church Road, excepting and excluding that part  
platted as Robert Salton Motel; also, the west  
628.75 feet of the Southeast Quarter (sqd) of  
said Section 32 lying south of Salton Church  
Road; also, the Northwest Quarter of the North-  
west Quarter (NW<sup>1/4</sup> of NW<sup>1/4</sup>) of Section 9, Township  
27 North, Range 22 West, of the Fourth Principal  
Meridian; also, that part of the Northwest  
Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1/4</sup> of NW<sup>1/4</sup>) of  
said Section 9 lying east of the west line of  
Robert Street (State Trunk Highway No. 3,  
formerly known as State Trunk Highway No. 210)  
excepting and excluding the south 200 feet  
thereof, all in Izard Grove Township, Dakota  
County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS said territory:

- (a) does not exceed two hundred (200) acres in area;
- (b) abuts upon said village of Sunfish Lake;
- (c) is not now included in any municipality; and
- (d) is suitably situated for municipal govern-  
ment; and,

WHEREAS, this Council has held a hearing on March 19, 1942, after  
an interval thirty (30) days pasted notice, on the annexation proposed and sought  
by the above petition; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that annexation of the above described territory to the Village of Sunfish Lake will be to the best interests of said Village and of the said territory, now, therefore,

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF SUNFISH LAKE CHAIRS:

SECTION I

That the following described territory is declared to be annexed to the Village of Sunfish Lake, Minnesota, to-wit:

That part of the Southwest Quarter ( $\text{SW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of Section 32, Township 28 North, Range 22 West, of the Fourth Principal Meridian, lying east of the west line of Robert Street (State Trunk Highway No. 3, formerly known as State Trunk Highway No. 218) and lying south of Salem Church Road, excepting and excluding that part platted as Robert Salem Vista; also, the west 618.75 foot of the Southeast Quarter ( $\text{SE}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of said Section 32 lying south of Salem Church Road; also, the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $\text{NE}^{\frac{1}{4}}$  of  $\text{NW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of Section 9, Township 27 North, Range 22 West, of the Fourth Principal Meridian; also, that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $\text{NW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$  of  $\text{NW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of said Section 9 lying east of the west line of Robert Street (State Trunk Highway No. 3, formerly known as State Trunk Highway No. 218) excepting and excluding the south 220 foot thereof, all in Inver Grove Township, Dakota County, Minnesota.

SECTION II

That the annexation herein provided shall be deemed final upon filing a copy of this Ordinance with the County Auditor for Dakota County, Minnesota, the Minnesota Secretary of State, and the Commission created by Law of Minnesota, 1959, Chapter 606, Section 1, as amended.
