We are in receipt of Ordinance of the Village of Kennedy annexing territory to the Village, pursuant to M.S. 414.03, subdivision 7.

The Ordinance does not state the jurisdictional facts necessary for annexation under this section and subdivision of the law, that is, either that it abuts on the municipality and is conditioned as properly to be subject to municipal government; or that the land is owned by the municipality; or that the land is completely surrounded by land within the municipal limits and that the statutory procedure in such cases has been followed; or that the land is platted or less than 200 acres and a petition of the majority of the owners has been received. The applicable sections should have been stated in the Ordinance and lacking that should be stated in a certificate. Will you please file such a certificate.
