Dear Sir:

We are in receipt of Ordinance of the Village of Kennedy annexing territory to the Village, pursuant to M.S. 414.03, subdivision 7.

The Ordinance does not state the jurisdictional facts necessary for annexation under this section and subdivision of the law, that is, either that it abuts on the municipality and is conditioned as properly to be subject to municipal government; or that the land is owned by the municipality; or that the land is completely surrounded by land within the municipal limits and that the statutory procedure in such cases has been followed; or that the land is platted or less than 200 acres and a petition of the majority of the owners has been received. The applicable sections should have been stated in the Ordinance and lacking that should be stated in a certificate. Will you please file such a certificate.



ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF KENNEDY
ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE

The Village Council of the Village of Kennedy, Kiatcon County, Minnesota, ordains that the following property is hereby declared annexed to the Village of Kennedy, and is hereby included within the Village Limits of the Village of Kennedy. The annexed property is described as follows:

A tract of land 177.5 feet by 331.7 feet lying and being in the Southwest one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township One hundred sixty (160), North of Range Forty-eight (48) West, described as follows: Commencing at a point, on the South section line of Section Thirty (30), Township One hundred sixty (160), North of Range Forty-eight (48) West, 1,332 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Section Thirty (30); thence, continuing on said South Section line a distance of 177.5 feet; thence at right angles in a Northerly direction, a distance of 331.7 feet; thence at right angles, in a Westerly direction, and parallel with the South Section Line of said Section Thirty (30), a distance of 177.5 feet; thence at right angles, in a Southerly direction, and parallel with the West Section Line of said Section Thirty (30), a distance of 331.7 feet to the point of beginning.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Petition duly executed by the officers of the Evangelical Mission Church of Kennedy, Minnesota, petitioning for the annexation of the hereinafter described property by the Village of Kennedy was presented by the Petitioners to the Village Council of the Village of Kennedy, and after due consideration of said Petition, the Village Council determines as follows:

That the hereinafter described property abuts on the Village of Kennedy and is so conditioned as properly to be subject to municipal government; that said property is not included in any other village, city or borough; that the statutory procedure has been followed; that said land is unplatted and does not exceed two hundred (200) acres; that all of the owners of said property have petitioned the Village Council to have such property included within the village; that the Evangelical Mission Church of Kennedy, Minnesota, is the owner of said property.

That the Council hereby determines that the annexation of said land will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory effected.

THEREFORE, it is hereby declared by the Village Council of the Village of Kennedy, that the following described real estate is annexed to the Village of Kennedy, and included within the Village Limits of the Village of Kennedy.

That the annexed property is described as follows:

A tract of land 177.5 feet by 331.7 feet lying and being in the Southwest one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township One hundred sixty (160), North of Range Forty-eight (48) West, described as follows: Commencing at a point, on the South section line of Section Thirty (30), Township One hundred sixty (160), North of Range Forty-eight (48) West, 1,332 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Section Thirty (30); thence, continuing on said South Section line a distance of 177.5 feet; thence at right angles in a Northerly direction, a distance of 331.7 feet; thence at right angles, in a Westerly direction, and parallel with the South Section Line of said Section Thirty (30), a distance of 177.5 feet; thence at right angles, in a Southerly direction, and parallel with the West Section Line of said Section Thirty (30), a distance of 331.7 feet to the point of beginning.

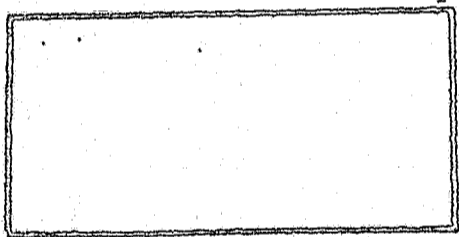




