WHEREAS, it is imperative that our citizens be informed of the treatment and care available to the victims of this disease; and


WHEREAS, a unique program will be held in Southeastern Minnesota to heighten the awareness of our citizens to the need for cancer education,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 1, 1962 as


"REGIONAL CANCER EDUCATION DAY"
