

PAGE SEVENTY ONE, ORDINANCE, RULES, BY-LAWS BOOK

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REGULAR ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTION:

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WANDA, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

SECTION I:

ALL VILLAGE ORDINANCES ORDAINED PRIOR TO JANUARY 4TH, 1962, IN REFERENCE TO THE DATE OF THE REGULAR ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTION ARE HEREBY RESCINDED.

SECTION II:

UNDER SECTION 205.07, CHAPTER 205, PARAGRAPH SUBDIVISION 1, DATE OF REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION HELD ANNUALLY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WANDA, MINNESOTA ORDAINS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 4, 1962 THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE:

THE REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION SHALL BE HELD ANNUALLY ON THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER IN ORDER TO COINCIDE WITH COUNTY, STATE & GENERAL ELECTIONS.

PRINTERS AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION
(Chapter 134, Laws of 1955.)

Richard E. Tonnell, being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher, editor of the newspaper known as the Watkins Forum, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Ordinance No. 73

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the Village of Watkins, in the County of Meeker, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the city from which it purports to be issued as above state and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to be at least 150 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that the press work on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve has been done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five percent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; that a copy of each issue has been filed with the State Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota; that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Meeker County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper.

That the Ordinance No. 73 hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published in the English language, once each week for one week successive weeks;

that it was first published on Thursday, the 22 day of March 1962 and thereafter on Thursday of each week to and including the 19 day of March 1962; and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 73
An Ordinance annexing abutting land to the Village of Watkins, Minnesota.

IT IS ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the Village of Watkins, Minnesota, at its Special meeting held on the 15th day of March, 1962, in the Village Hall.

SECTION I

That the following described land situated in Meeker County, Minnesota, to-wit:
Beginning 66 feet east and 320 feet South of the Northwest corner of Northeast Quarter of (NE¼ of NE¼) of Section Eleven (11), Township One Hundred Twenty-one (121), Range Thirty (30), thence due East 235 feet; thence due North 320 feet; thence due West 235 feet; thence South 320 feet to the place of beginning,
abutting upon the incorporated limits of the Village of Watkins, Meeker County, Minnesota, and containing less than 200 acres, of land, be and the same is hereby annexed to said Village and shall become a part of said Village as effectively as if it had been originally a part thereof. The Council has determined that it is for the best interest of all concerned that said land be annexed.

SECTION II

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication. Passed by the Village Council this 15th day of March, 1962.
