

ORDINANCE NO. 112

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND TO THE VILLAGE OF OLIVIA.

The Council of the Village of Olivia do ordain as follows:

Section 1 - The following described platted real estate abutting upon the incorporated Village of Olivia is hereby annexed to such village and shall become a part of such village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 16 of Sunset Acres, being a subdivision of part of Outlet 1 and Lot H in the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 115, Range 35.

Section 2 - The following described unplatted real estate abutting upon the incorporated Village of Olivia is hereby annexed to such village and shall become a part of such village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

That part of the South Half of Section 12, Township 115, Range 35, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the southerly right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railway Company, which is the present westerly boundary of the limits of the Village of Olivia, thence extending in a westerly direction along the southerly right-of-way line of said railway to the west line of said Section 12, thence extending in a southerly direction along said section line to the southerly right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 212, thence extending in an easterly direction along said southerly line of U. S. Highway 212 to the east line of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 12, thence extending in a northerly direction to the northwest corner of Lot 16 of Sunset Acres, thence extending in an easterly direction along the north line of said Lot 16 and Lot 9 of Sunset Acres, thence running in a northerly direction along the present Village boundary to the point of beginning.

RESOLUTION

At a duly called and held meeting of the Village Council of Olivia, Minnesota, the matter of annexation of land to the Village of Olivia came up for discussion. From the information available to the Council and upon the verified petition of all of the owners of the hereinafter described property, it appears that the real estate hereinafter described is properly conditioned so as to be subjected to and benefited by municipal government and that the annexation as proposed will be to the best interests of the owners of said real estate and to the Village of Olivia.

After discussion of said matter, Trustee H. S. Nelson proposed the following resolution and moved its adoption, to-wit:

WHEREAS, all of the owners of lands abutting upon the Village of Olivia have petitioned for the annexation of said lands to the incorporated Village of Olivia, and

WHEREAS, the platted portion of such lands is described as:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 16 of Sunset Acres, being a subdivision of part of Outlet 1 and Lot M in the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 115, Range 35; Renville County, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, THE UNPLATTED PORTION OF said lands is described as:

That part of the South Half of Section 12, Township 115, Range 35, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the southerly right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railway Company, which is the present westerly boundary of the limits of the Village of Olivia, thence extending in a westerly direction along the southerly right-of-way line of said railway to the west line of said Section 12, thence extending in a southerly direction along said section line to the southerly right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 212, thence extending in an easterly direction along said southerly line of U. S. Highway 212 to the east line of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 12, thence extending in a northerly direction to the northwest corner of Lot 16 of Sunset Acres, thence extending in an easterly direction along the north line of said Lot 16 and Lot 9 of Sunset Acres, thence running in a northerly direction along the present Village boundary to the point of beginning; and

WHEREAS, the said real estate is properly conditioned for administration by a municipal government and it will be to the best interests of the Village of Olivia and to the

owners of said lands that said real estate be annexed to the corporate Village of Olivia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Olivia Village Council that the attached petition be granted and the real estate therein described and above described, be and the same is hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the Village of Olivia, Minnesota.

Trustee Maria L. Erickson seconded the motion for the adoption of such resolution and upon submission thereof, said resolution was declared duly adopted.
