

Resolution.

Whereas, It appears by the return of the election board presiding at the annual village election held in and for this village on the 14th day of March, 1916, and by the canvass of the said returns duly made by the canvassing board that at said election there were cast 77 ballots for, and 10 ballots against, the proposition of relinquishing the charter under which this village was organized and of being thenceforth governed as provided by Chapter 9 of the General Statutes of 1913, which said proposition was duly submitted at said annual village election pursuant to a resolution passed by this council.

Now, Therefore, It is hereby Resolved, by the village council of the village of Carver, Minn., that it declare, and it hereby declares, that at said annual village election a majority of the votes cast upon said proposition were in the affirmative, and that, pursuant to law, on the proper filing of certified copies of this resolution the former charter shall cease and the applicable provisions of said Chapter 9 of the General Statutes of 1913 be substituted therefor.
