PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, there is further need to pool private initiative and consolidate the resources of state government in the continuing drive for more jobs; and

WHEREAS, an important phase of the effort concerns the youth of Minnesota and the task of providing the education and training to equip them for satisfying work in rewarding careers in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, I have called a Statewide Conference on Youth Employment and Training for April 23-24 at the Leamington Hotel, Minneapolis, to bring public focus on three objectives: First, to encourage young people to stay in school and secure as much training as possible to meet the increasing technological demands of the future; Second, to find more summer jobs for youth to enable them to continue their education through satisfying, wholesome, short-term employment where they will not be competing with working men and heads of families who are seeking full-time jobs; and Third, to find full-time jobs in Minnesota for young people; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Employment Service, affiliated with the U. S. Employment Service, is gearing for an intensive drive toward this three-phased objective,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, designate the period of time between April 16 and December 31, 1962 to this objective:

PUT YOUTH ON A JOB:  
TODAY'S INVESTMENT, TOMORROW'S PROFIT

and urge all Minnesotans to join this effort to provide more opportunities--educational and economic--for youth, which is Minnesota's greatest resource.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this ninth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, and of the State the one hundred fourth.
