ORDER OF INCORPORATION

Upon proper notice, the Minnesota Municipal Commission met on May 15, 1962, at 10:00 A.M., in Room 74 of the State Office Building, St. Paul, Minnesota, to canvas the results of the St. Francis election held on May 1, 1962, as a result of an order of the Commission dated March 21, 1962. The canvas showed that all statutory requirements had been met, and that incorporation had been favorably passed on by the electors, by a vote of 141 to 52.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That St. Francis be incorporated as a village as of May 16, 1962.

IT IS ORDERED: That the boundaries of the proposed village shall be the same as stated in the attached order of the Commission, dated March 21, 1962, ordering the election.

IT IS ORDERED: That the new village immediately proceed under 412.021 of Minnesota statutes to set an election for first officers of the village, on June 12, 1962, at St. Francis High School.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That a copy of this order be filed with the Secretary of State and Anoka County Auditor.




