## EXECUTIVE ORDER

ACCEPTING RETIREMENT APPLICATION OF THE HONORABLE WILLIAM C. CHRISTIANSON AND EXTENDING FOR ONE YEAR HIS PRESENT TERM OF OFFICE

- WHEREAS, the Honorable William C. Christianson, Judge of the First Judicial District, Goodhue County, Red Wing, Minnesota, will attain the age of 70 years on December 5, 1962, and
- WHEREAS, Judge Christianson on that date will have served for fourteen years as a Judge of the Supreme and District Courts of Minnesota, and
- WHEREAS, the six year term, for which Judge Christianson was elected on November 3, 1956, will expire January 7, 1963, which date is less than three years from the time when he would become eligible to retire under the provisions of M.S.A. Sections 490.101 and 490.102, and
- WHEREAS, Judge Christianson has presented in writing his application for retirement stating his intention to retire upon eligibility pursuant to the provisions of said Section 490.101, Subd. 4; it is hereby
- ORDERED, that Judge Christianson's application for retirement be accepted as submitted, and
- ORDERED, also, that Judge Christianson's present term of office, expiring the first Monday in January 1963 be and hereby is extended for one year, and
- ORDERED, further, that a copy of this Order be filed in the offices of the State Auditor and the Secretary of State.
