

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF AMBOY, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated June 1st, 1962, requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the council on the 4th day of June 1962; and

The Council of the Village of Amboy ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows: Beginning at a point 60 feet South of iron-pipe on the Southwest corner of Lot 10, Block 2, Truse's Addition to the Village of Amboy, the same point being the Northwest corner of Lot 11, Block 3, of said Truse's Addition to the Village of Amboy; thence South along said Lot 11, 150 feet; thence West parallel with Main Street of the Village of Amboy, 80 feet; thence North 150 feet to the South line of South Street of the Village of Amboy; thence East along the South line of said South Street of the Village of Amboy, 80 feet, to the place of beginning.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the secretary of state and in the office of the county auditor of Blue Earth County.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 2.
