A PROCLAMATION FOR "BETTER HEARING MONTH"

WHEREAS the American Hearing Society and its local member agencies, Minneapolis Hearing Society and St. Paul Hearing Society, have for the health and welfare of the hearing impaired, have designated the month of May, 1962 as "Better Hearing Month"; and

WHEREAS the local societies devote their entire efforts and resources in behalf of the State of Minnesota's estimated 15,000 persons, including approximately 5,000 children, who have some degree of hearing loss; and

WHEREAS this observance is designed to acquaint the public with facilities available to the hard of hearing to point out the need for expansion of services for acoustically handicapped children and adults; and

WHEREAS deafness can frequently be prevented through early discovery and prompt medical treatment, as indicated;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare the month of May, 1962 as

"BETTER HEARING MONTH"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to avail themselves of this opportunity to become better informed of the programs sponsored by these organizations and cooperate with their efforts in behalf of those who suffer a loss of hearing
