

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAND MEADOW IN MOWER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, That the proposition of re-incorporating said Village under the provisions of Chapter nine (9) of the General Statutes of Minnesota for 1905¹⁹⁰⁵ and laws amendatory thereto and supplementary thereof having been duly and legally submitted to a vote of the electors of said Village at its annual Village election held on the 3rd day of April 1916, said election on said proposition of re-incorporating resulted as follows, to-wit:

One Hundred Sixty-four ballots were cast upon the proposition of re-incorporating.

One Hundred Fifty-three ballots were in favor of re-incorporating.

Four ballots were against re-incorporating.

Seven ballots were left blank.

The proposition of re-incorporating the Village of Grand Meadow, in Mower County, Minnesota, under the provisions of Chapter nine (9) of the General Statutes of Minnesota for 1905¹⁹⁰⁵ and laws amendatory thereto and supplementary thereof was therefore carried.

Passed and approved by the Village Council of the Village of Grand Meadow in Mower County, Minnesota, at a regular meeting thereof held in said Village on the 11th day of April 1916.
