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ORDINANCE 63
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE VILLAGE OF COLOGNE, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. - Petitions have been filed with the governing body of the Village of Cologne, Minnesota, by the sole owner of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Cologne, Minnesota:

Tract 1. - Owned by Edward Carlson and Mattie Carlson husband and wife -

The East 75 feet of the West 320 feet of the following described tract: Beginning at a point which is 3034.12 feet (55.8525 chains) North of the quarter post on the South side of Section 15, Township 115 Range 25 West; thence North on said North and South quarter line of said Section 316.50 feet; (4.7025 chains) to a post; thence East 293.95 feet (5.35 chains) to a point where it intersects the North line of the Chicago, Milwaukee St. Paul and Pacific Railway Company's right of way; thence Southwesterly along said Railway Company's right of way to the place of beginning.

Tract 2. - Owned by Ida Maulsara -

Commencing at a point 52 feet North and 155 feet East from the Southwest corner of the North half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 15 Township 115 Range 25; thence North 132 feet to a point; thence East 65 feet to a point; thence South 132 feet to a point; thence West 60 feet to the place of beginning, containing .15 acre, more or less and situated in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 15 Township 115 Range 25.

Section 2. - The quantity of land embraced within the Carlson tract above described is 2.74 acres and the quantity of land embraced within the Maulsara tract is .15 acre.

Section 3. - The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of Cologne, Minn., and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditional as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section 4. - Therefore, the Village of Cologne, Minn., hereby ordains and declares that the property heretofore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of Cologne, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. - This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after the filing of certified copies thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
