A PROGLAMATION FOR B'NAI B'RITH WEEK

WHEREAS, it has pioneered in cultural and social programs and stressed, through educational media, the responsibility of all citizens to participate in the affairs of the city, state and nation. WHEREAS, it is fitting that recognition should be given to B'nai B'rith on the occasion of its District Grant Lodge 6 Convention, and that the week of July 8 be set aside in its observance;
