A PROGLAMATION FOR "CAPTIVE NATIONS WEEK"

WHEREAS, many nations of the world have been made captive by the imperialistic and aggressive policies of Soviet Communica and the peoples of the Soviet-dominated nations have been deprived of their national independence and their individual liberties; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and proper to manifest to the peoples of the captive nations the support of the American people for their just aspirations for freedom and national independence; and

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States took recognition of the need of Captive Nations week by joint resolution approved July 17, 1950; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota played a major role in securing approval of the resolution through the leadership of Congressman Walter Judd and the favorable support of all its Congressman and Senators;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of July 15-20, 1962 as

"CAPTIVE NATIONS WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to fully realize their obligation to do all things possible to supplant authoritarian rule and tyranny with the principles of freedom and human rights.

IN WITHESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this minth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred sixtytwo and of the State the one hundred fifth.
