- WHEREAS, more than 72,000 of our citizens live in mobile homes in this state and these families spend nearly \$1,500,000 each week for the ordinary staples of family living; and
- WHEREAS, they are good citizens, and serve an important part in the state's civic life, taking part in social, religious, civic, and political affairs; and
- WHEREAS, these good citizens comprise a cross section of vocations, including students of higher learning, doctors, attorneys, executives, skilled and unskilled laborers, and the retired--our senior citizens; and
- WHEREAS, the mobile home industry is clearly an important economic segment of our life in Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 23-29, 1962 as

"MOBILE HOME WEEK"


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to direct their attention to this observance.
