Extending the corporate limits of the City of Austin to the Southeast.

WHEREAS, The Fellowship Methodist Church, a religious corporation of Austin, Minnesota, is the solo owner of the land hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the said owner above-mentioned has petitioned the Common Council of Austin, Minnesota to have the hereinafter described premises annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Austin, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, said premises adjoin the City of Austin and are subject to corporation within the corporate limits of Austin, Minnesota, by petition to the governing body of the City of Austin, and

WHEREAS, said premises hereinafter described are about to become urban in character and municipal government of the area hereinafter described is required in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare of said territory and to regulate construction therein which may be reasonably expected to occur within a reasonable time, and annexation of the premises hereinafter described is for the best interest of the City of Austin, Minnesota, and for the territory to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, said premises are well fitted to be under municipal government and are well adopted for municipal use, and

WHEREAS, the premises hereinafter described desire to be annexed are less than two hundred (200) acres and the petition for annexation has been signed by all of the owners of the annexed property.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, MINNESOTA DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Land hereinafter described be added to and incorporated within the corporate limits of the City of Austin, Minnesota, and said Common Council does hereby declare said premises hereinafter described to be incorporated within and to be a part of the City of Austin, Minnesota. The premises are described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the East line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 2, Township 102 North, Range 18 West, 670.82 feet North of the Southeast Corner of said Section 2, thence West 1,170.52 feet to the center line of Lyman Lane (now known as 15th Street S. E.) in the City of Austin extended South, thence South 348 feet along the center of Lyman Lane (now known as 15th Street S. E.) extended South to the center line of Seventh Avenue S. E. extended West, thence East along the center line of Seventh Avenue S. E. as extended, 1,170.52 feet, thence North 348 feet to the point of beginning, all of said premises being in Mower County, Minnesota.

SECTION 2. The above-described land extending the corporate limits of the City of Austin, Minnesota shall be added to the end of 2300.63, Austin Compilation in the regular chronological order.

SECTION 3. Said annexation shall not be final until copies of these ordinances have been filed with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor of the County of Mower, State of Minnesota.
