Dear Governor Anderson:

Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 355 of the Revised Statutes of the United States (40 U. S. C. sec. 235) that exclusive jurisdiction is accepted in behalf of the United States in and over the following described tract of land containing 50 acres, more or less, acquired in 1943 as an addition to the Federal Correctional Institution, Sandstone, Minnesota, and I hereby apply for a certificate by you evidencing the consent of the State of Minnesota to the exercise of such jurisdiction, as provided by section 1.046 of Minnesota Statutes 1945:

South Half (1/2) of the Northeast Quarter
(NE 1/4) of Section Fifteen (15), Township
Forty-two (42) North of Range Twenty (20)
West of the Fourth Principle Meridian.

The Land was acquired by the United States by purchase under a warranty deed dated March 25, 1943, from Rudolph E. Tholin, et al., which is recorded in Book 97 of Deeds at page 154 in the office of the Register of Deeds of Pine County, State of Minnesota. A copy of the deed, certified as to authenticity and the vesting of title thereunder by the Director of the Bureau of Prisons pursuant to section 599.10 of Minnesota Statutes 1945, is enclosed.

The United States acquired exclusive jurisdiction over the Federal Correctional Institution at Sandstone under the laws of

the State of Minnesota prior to 1940. Such jurisdiction over the above additional tract, however, has not been acquired because the notice of acceptance of jurisdiction has not been filed with you as required by amendment of section 355 of the Revised Statutes of the United States by the Act of February 1, 1940 (54 Stat. 19). It is desirable from the standpoint of administration of the correctional institution that Federal jurisdiction over the premises be complete.

A draft of the certificate for execution by you in duplicate, prepared for your convenience, is enclosed. As you know, one copy is to be filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and the other copy is to be sent to me for recording in Pine County in which the land is situated.

Jurisdiction over Federal Correctional Institution

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota ceded to the United States prior to 1940 exclusive jurisdiction over the premises of the Federal Correctional Institution at Sandstone, Minnesota (Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, section 6.1, as amended by Laws of Minnesota 1939, chapter 17);

WHEREAS, the United States added to said premises by purchase made in 1943 an eighty acre tract of land as herein- after described, and proof has been furnished that title to said land vested and continues to be vested in the United States;

WHEREAS, jurisdiction over said additional tract has not been accepted in behalf of the United States as required by the Act of Congress of February 1, 1940, (54 Stat. 19), amending section 355 of the Revised Statutes of the United States (40 U. S. C. sec. 255), and as provided by the amendment of section 1.042 of Minnesota Statutes 1945 by chapter 85 of the Laws of Minnesota 1959; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General of the United States has filed notice in behalf of the United States of acceptance of exclusive jurisdiction over said eighty acre addition and has applied for the issuance of a certificate pursuant to section 1.046 of Minnesota Statutes 1945, evidencing the consent of the State to the acquisition of, and to the exercise of exclusive jurisdiction, by the United States in and over said addition

to said premises;


NDW, THEREFORE, I hereby declare that the State of Minnesota has consented to the acquisition by the United States of the following described land and has ceded to the United States exclusive jurisdiction in and over said land as a part of the premises of the Federal Correctional Institution at Sandstone, Minnesota, in accordance with section 1.042 of Minnesota Statutes 1945, as amended:

South Half (1/2) of the Northeast Quarter
(NE 1/4) of Section Fifteen (15), Township
Forty-two (42) North of Range Twenty
(20) West of the Fourth Principle Meridian.


AND I do hereby certify, pursuant to section 1.046 of Minnesota Statutes 1945, that the above described land was acquired by the United States by authority of the Congress of the United States (49 Stat. 1329) for addition to the premises of the Federal Correctional Institution at Sandstone, Minnesota, and for the purposes of said Institution; that said land was acquired by purchase from Rudolph E. Thalín, Elsie C. Thalín, Florence C. Helming, Carlton T. Helming, Ruth T. Lynch, Jake L. Lynch, and Evelyn V. Thalín, who conveyed said land to the United States by warranty deed dated March 25, 1943, recorded in Book 97 of Deeds at page 154 in the office of the Register of Deeds of Pine County, State of Minnesota; and that said cession of exclusive jurisdiction to the United States in and over said land is in accordance with section 1.042 of Minnesota Statutes 1945, as amended, and Article I, section 8, clause 17 of the


Constitution, and section 355 of the Revised Statutes, of the
