

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE DATE OF THE VILLAGE ELECTION FOR THE VILLAGE OF EMMONS, MINNESOTA, GIVING EFFECTIVE DATE AS OF VILLAGE ELECTION 1962.

The Village Council of the Village of Emmons does ordain:

Section I.

With reference to State Statutes regulating Village Elections.

The regular Village elections shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in December every year. This regulation is hereby changed by the vote of the Village Council to be held every year beginning with the year 1962 as follows:

The Annual Village Election will hereafter be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November. Polling hours, Offices to be filled, and Issues will be posted and published each year two weeks before such election date is realized.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law in the State Of Minnesota.
