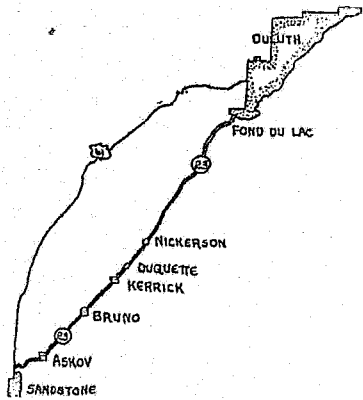

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST HOLIDAY IN NOVEMBER OF EACH YEAR AS THE DATE OF THE ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTIONS.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ASKOV, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS

Section 1. Commencing with the 1962 village election, the regular

village election of Askov shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first holiday of each year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
